and Perfect Sense Do Make and Ordain this to be my Last will and Testament
In Manner following and first I Recommend my Soul into the Hands of all
mighty God who gave it Me and my Body to the Earth whome it was Taken
to be Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named
and as for my Personal Estate I Dispose of as followeth Viz:
I Give and Bequeath unto my Son William Portlock fifty Acres of Land More or
Less the plantation of Lower Green to him and his Heirs for Ever Beside
the Use of it to My Loving wife During her Natural Life
I Give and Bequeath unto my son Caleb Portlock my Gun that my father gave me
with him and his heirs for Ever when he shall come of Age to Receive it
I Give and Bequeath to my son Thomas Portlock My other Gun that is fixed with
Bayonets also my beautiful box and the Bayonets Belongs to the said Gun to be Delivered
to him when he shall Beside to Receive it
My will and Mind is that my Loving wife Annas Portlock shall have the
Use of all my Estates as heres before I did live and also the Use of My Negro
woman Hannah During her Natural Life and after the Decease of my
Loving wife my Stocks of all Kinds to be Equally Divided Between my
Three Sons William Caleb and Thomas Portlock and as for my Negro woman
Hannah after the Decease of my Loving wife to be Equally Divided Between
my Two sons Caleb and Thomas to them and their heirs for Ever and I Give unto my Executors
full power to Sell or Dispose of my Negro woman Hannah ^{if you see fit} and the Money Aris-
ing for the said Hannah to my Executors to purchase another in her Stead
Either man or woman boy or girl to be for the Use of my Two sons after the
Decease of my Loving wife Annas Portlock
Caleb and Thomas and my Wife that there be no Appraisement to my Estate
but an Inventory may be Taken by my Ex^{ors} and by them kept and Not Returned
to the Court and that I Do Nominate and Appoint my Loving wife Annas
Portlock and my Brother in Law Thomas Nash to be my whole and Sole
Executors and Administrators of this my Last will and Testament Given by my
all other wills by me here after made In Witness whereof this 15th
Day of April 1758 Entered in the 27th Line after the Decease of
