of them to my Beloved wife Marthay Poworth her & her
Heir for life time And likewise my Maid called and known by
the Name of Maddam.

Item After my Decease I Give to my wife Marthay Poworth Six
Milk cows and their calves and one pair of Working Steer.
And one feather bed and furniture taking her Chosen of
them I Give them to her and her heirs for ever.

Item After my Decease I Give to my Son William Poworth and
his heirs for ever one pair of young Steer and Six head of
Cattel and one Bed and furniture and by Deed of my own Hand

Item After my Decease I Give to my Son Molten Poworth and
his heirs for ever one Bed and furniture and Bed Stead
And my Riding horse Saddel and Bridel

Item After my Decease I Give to my wife Marthay Poworth
my hand Mill two Iron pots and Six Cheair and two
Tables two puter Dishes and Six plates one Lining wheel
and Wooling wheel and Saff and two Chirts one Large
one and one Small one and all my Sheep and all my Tree
wood with one Lot of Chene to her and her heirs for ever

Item After my Decease I Give my wife Marthay Two Sows and
pigg and nine Large hogs more

Item After my Decease I leave all the Rest of my Moveable
estate for to be sold and the money for to be Equally
Divided among my three children their Names as
followeth

God And Wholly beging pardoning for my Many fold sins and
all wicked Deeds of this world, and, hoping To sing Merem from
To Prisoners and Living a father, We Shall Repreuduced
life all the blessed for to beate My Blessed Rodomere
To be my Blessed Father. The Kingdom of your father -
I shall put my hope on to Made full and glorious a God
I shall put my hope in to his hands: That Gave it me, and as for
My Body after my Decease for to be Decently Buried By the
Order and Direction of My Executors.

Item 1 After My Decease I Leave my Negro woman Lowith and
My Negro woman, Hannah, that is to say the Use and Labor
of them to my Beloved wife Marthay Pobworth her share
for the Lifetime And like wife my Meave Called and known by
the Name of Maddam.

Item 2 After my Decease I Give to my wife Marthay Pobworth Six
Milk cows and their calves and one pair of Working Stear.
And one feather bed and furniture taking her share of
them, I give them to her and her heirs for ever.

Item 3 After my Decease I Give to my Son William Pobworth and
his heirs for ever one pair of young Stear and six heads of
Cattel and one Bed and furniture and I Resid the my own Goods

Item 4 After my Decease I Give to my Son Molten Pobworth and
his heirs for ever one Bed and furniture and Bed Stead
And My Riding hors Saddle and Bridel

Item 5 After my Decease I Give to my wife Marthay Pobworth
My hand Mill tow Iron pots and six Cheair and tow
Tables tow puter Dish and six plates one Lining wheel
and Wooling wheel and Sape and tow Christ one Large
one and one Small one and all my Sheep and all my Tree
wear with one Lot of Chace to her and her heirs for ever

Item 6 After My Decease I Give my wife Marthay Tow Sows and
pigg and nine Large hodge more

Item 7 After my Decease I Leave all the Rest of my Moveable
estate for to be sold and the money for to be Equally
Divided amongst my Seven Children their shares as
followeth

Carried over to the Other Side and ther they are named

Brought Over

The Money that my Movable Estate that is not willd
away for this is for to be Equally Divided amongst Robert
Pobworth Plaphant Jane pobworth Mary Pobworth
Honorij Pobworth Lucanah Pobworth James Pobworth and
Thomas Pobworth

After the Decease of my wife Marthay Pobworth I leave
my Son Negro Lewis and Hannah for To Be paid
and my Son William for to have my Negro man Lewis
and my Son Mollen my Negro woman Hannah paying
To the four Brothers and three Sisters their Equall parts
of the Said Value of the tow Negroes as if they had
been Sold and Divided amongst them as is
This my Last will and Testament and I bequeath Disat-
-ful and Make void all former wills what so Ever
As Witness my hand and Seale This 20 Day of January
1766 I leave my wife Marthay my hole and sole Exectrix
Signed and Sealed } William }
and Declared } Mark }
