any Daughter Sarah Tarts and to her Heirs forever and if she should
out Issue, Give the Use & Profits of my said Plantation to my wife Elizabeth
During her Natural Life & then to the Vestry of Portsmouth Parish aforesaid
and to their Successors, for them to let out the said Plantation once in every four
years to come, and Money arising therefrom to be appropriated to the Main-
tenance of the Poor of the said Parish.
