Joshua Wilkins to him and his Heirs and Assigns forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving Wife Thamar Wil-
kins the use of my Water Mill with one Acre of Land on the
Road Side and all the Land joining Malachi and David Crah-
mer on their Sides until ~~John~~ Wilkins Son of Joshua ~~Wilkins~~
comes to lawful Age of Twenty One years, & then to him. And
if John Wilkins should die without Heirs then to go to his bro-
ther Joshua Wilkins to him and his Heirs and Assigns forever
Item I give and bequeath unto Joshua Wilkins Son of Joshua the Land I
bought of Caleb McHoy containing Ninety Three Acres more or less
and if he should die without Heirs then the above Land to go to William

bought of Caleb McRoy containing Ninety Three Acres more or less
and if he should die without Heirs then the above Land to go to William
Wilkins his Brother to him and his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving Wife Thamar Wil-
kins the use of my Negroes, during her Life To, Pompey, Bob,
Danie Amerciai Jenny & Cady

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Thamar Wilkins,
Negro Rose, Janny, Sandy, Jasper and Jack to her and her
Heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my loving Wife Thamar Wilkins the use of my
Still, Cap, and Worm, and after her decease I give the
above Still to my ~~son~~ Godson Henry Wilson to him and
his Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Godson Henry Wilson after the
Death of my loving Wife the Sum of Fifty Pound. Current
Money to him and his Heirs.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Thamar Wilkins the
use of all my Stock during her Life consisting of Cattle Hor-
ses Sheep and Hogs household goods and Plantation Utensils

and after her Death to be sold the above mentioned by my
Executors.

Item My Will and desire is that my Negroes may be sold that
I give my Wife the use of and their Increase after the
Death of my Wife and the Money to be equally divided
amongst Joshua Wilkins Children. Henry Wilson Chil-
dren had by my Sister Elizabeth and the Daughters
of James Wilkins Tobey. Elizabeth Teebear, and Franky
and Lastly I nominate and appoint my Dear and
Loving Wife Thamer Wilkins and Henry Wilson Exe-
cutors of this my last Will and Testament in Testi-
mony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
the Eighteen Day of March 1777.
