Item. I give unto William Christian my Negroes Shadrach & George, also the first choice of my horse kind to him and his heirs.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Luanna Christian daughter of Michael Christian all my whole Estate after my Just Debts are paid, that is to say, all my Lands and Negroes, and all other Estate whatever (the two Negroes and Horse above mentioned accepted, to her & her Heirs.

Item. My Will also is that John Hagg & John Darby both or either be my Execut^r of this my last Will & Testament, and have the Settling of my Estate In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal.
