 and my Will is, that my ^{negro} boy called Joe be sold.

Item I Give to my Daughter Molly Dixon one Negro Girl called
 Sarah.

Item I Give to my Daughter Sarah Dixon one Negro boy
 called Isaac.

Item I Give to my Son John Dixon my Land, and one Negro
 Girl called Uddah.

Item I Give to my Son Thomas Dixon one Negro Girl called
 Comfort, and one Negro boy called Peter. My Will is that all
 my Children live with their Mother til they come to lawful
 age, my Will is, that all my Estate that I ha'nt before given be
 equally divided between my loving Wife Anne Mary Dixon
 and all my Children hereafter named: Molly, Sarah, John &
Thomas Dixon, to be divided immediately after my Death.

Girl called Adah

Item I Give to my Son Thomas Dixon one Negro Girl called Comfort. and one Negro Boy called Peter. My Will is that all my Children live with their Mother til they come to lawful age, my Will is, that all my Estate that I ha'nt before given be equally divided between my loving Wife Anne Mary Dixon and all my Children hereafter named: Molly, Sarah, John & Thomas Dixon, to be divided immediately after my Death. I appoint my loving Wife Anne Mary Dixon Executrix to this my last Will & Testament this twenty ^{fifth} Day of January seventeen hundred & sixty four
