Wiltshire river, to him and his heirs and assigns forever. I Give
also and bequeath to my beloved wife Sally Faulke, five negroes by
name Bob, Millie, Nance, Hannah, & Bet. also all the residue of
my Land and property of every kind, both real and personal to
her and her heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby appoint, my wife
Sally Faulke, Brother Joe Faulke and uncle Mr Faulke executors
to this my last Will and testament, in Wiltshire whereof, I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of January 1885.

to this my last Will and testament, in Witness whereof, I have
hereunto set my hand seal this fourth day of January 1860.
