

In Virtue of the powers vested in us the Subscribers by the Last Will & Testament of Daniel Jones Deceased of Record in the County of Nottoway. We have Divided the upper Division of Land belonging to the estate of said Jones dec'd. except the widow's dower Land. the lower Divisions having been made choice of by Littleberry H Jones and Theod. Jones two of the legatees named in the said will the lines and boundaries of which will fully appear by a former Return of a Division in part of the said Land, made by the subscribers, and recorded in Nottoway County Court; George Jones one of the legatees in the said will named, having attained the age of Twenty years, being desirous of possessing his part or portion of ~~that~~ part of the dec'd. Land that has not been allotted the Subscribers have established the following Line Dividing the upper part of the said Land into two societies A.R.P. beginning where the road crosses the line extending from Buckskin Creek to Moss Creek that separates the two lower divisions from the two upper divisions thence up the said road until it strikes the line the Eastern boundaries of the Dower Land of said Estate now held by the said Catherine Fitzgerald the Land lying on the north side of said road, being determined by the Subscribers as one lot or moiety and that on the South side of the said road the others; Whereup George Jones being authorized by the Testators Wills made choice of the

line extending from Buckskin Creek to West Creek that separates the two Lower divisions from the two upper divisions thence up the said road until it strikes the line the Eastern boundaries of the Davery Land of said Estate now held by the said Catherine Fitzgerald the Land lying on the north side of said road being determined by the Subscribers as one lot or moiety and that on the South side of the said road the other; Whereup Georg Jones being authorized by the Executors Will made choice of that moiety or parcel lying on the north side of the said road; In consequence of which choice we did allot & assign to him the same as his full share and portion of the Lands belonging to his Fathers Estate and which are not comprised in the aforesaid Davery.
