In the name of God Amen. I Edmund Hills Sen^r of Notoway County being of a sound disposing mind and Memory do Make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit. Inprimis. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Haynes Coleman after the death of my wife One negroe woman by the name of Winney and her future increase to her and her heirs forever. I also give unto my said daughter the negroe girl Sarah which she now has in possession and her increase to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary one negroe girl by the name of Mourning and one by the name of Dacey which she is not to possess until the death of my wife, and then I give them

to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy, after the death of my wife two Negroe girls, by name Clarissa and Lissy, all which I give unto her and her heirs forever. Item I give unto my loving wife Elizabeth my whole estate both real and personal except the Negroe Girl Sarah before given to my daughter Mary H. Coleman during her natural life, and at her death all that I have not particularly bequeathed I desire may be equally divided between my Sons Math^{rs} Wills, Willis Wills, Edm^d Wills, Lawrence H. Wills, Elias Wills, Wm Wills, John Wills, and Simon Wills, but it is my will and desire that my executors herein after named shall take the proportion given to my son Edm^d Wills into their hands, and after paying my son Willis Wills the amount of the debt due from my son Edm^d unto my son Willis, that they shall furnish him with necessaries for his support at their discretion. My will and desire is, that all my Just debts be paid out of my estate at the discretion of my executors herein after named; and lastly I do constitute and appoint, my loving wife Elizabeth Executrix. My nephew Edm^d Wills, my Son, Willis Wills and Burwell Coleman Executors to this my last will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former Wills by me made.
