in the State of Virginia being aged, infirm and weak in body and being con-
scious that it is appointed for all men once to die, do in my right mind, memo-
ry & senses make this my last Will & Testament, In witness, that is first I
bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it me hoping & fully trusting
that I shall be received into the Heavenly Chace through the merit of my dear
redemer Jesus Christ who suffered for me and all mankind, my body I commit
to the Earth from whence it came to be therein buried in a Christian like manner by
my Exors. hereafter named, and as to which Worldly Estate I hath pleased God to
bestow me with I give and dispose of in form & manner as follows (to wit)

Item First of all I leave all my Just Debts and Burial Expenses ~~the~~ paid out of the most
wasteful part of my estate;

Item I lend to my wife Etta Jackson during her Widowhood one hundred & eight
Acres of my land which I now possess to be taken off where she pleases so that
she join the old time equitable ~~my~~ land that lies on the North side of the
Blue Branch also four tracts named James, Arden, Com. & Robbin Street

all my stock of horses, cattle & Geese & all my household & kitchen furniture
except that part of my stock & household furniture that I shall give out;
Item I give to my son Daniel Jackson five shillings specie at the Division of
my estate;

Item I give to my Daughter Melinda Hammons five shillings specie at the
Division of my estate;

Item I give to my son Edward Jackson one hundred acres of land adjoining the
lands of Mr. Parviz Jackson, John May & Charles Sallard which Land he
hath a Deed for unrecorded to him this heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my Daughter Lucy Jackson five shillings specie at the Division of
my estate;

Item I give to my sons William Parviz Jackson Two hundred acres of Land adjour-
ing the lands of William Spain, Samree Hobbs & John May which Land he
hath a Deed for, unrecorded, also one negro Girl named Aggy & her
increase to him this heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Howard five shillings specie at the
Division of my estate;

Item I give to my son John Jackson all my Land & plantation that I now possess, also one
Negro man named Moses, one Negro Woman named Hannah with all her future
increase, one cow and calf, one feather Bed and furniture, one saddle, Mare which
was got by Granbey, and my still to him and his heirs or assigns forever, also
my Beaupair when he hath the house;

Item I give to my Daughter Silvana Grant one Negro Girl named Liddy and her
increase to her and her heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my Daughter Phoebe Whitesides one Negro Girl named Minney and her
increase, which girl she has in possession with a Deed of Gift for the same
on record to her and her heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son Benedict Jackson one Negro Girl named Lucy and her
increase which he has now in possession to him and his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son Moses Jackson five Shillings Specie at the Division of my estate.

Item I give to my son Ephraim Jackson one Negro Woman named Phoebe with all her
future increase to him & his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son John Jackson one Negro Boy named Jeremiah to him and

increase to him & his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son Woody Jackson one Negroe Boy named Jeremiah to him and his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son Ambrose Jackson one Negroe Girl named Charlott and her increase to him and his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my son Reuben Jackson one Negroe Girl named Judah & her increase to him and his heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give to my four Sons to wit, Benedicte Jackson, Ephraim Jackson, Woody Jackson, Ambrose Jackson and Reuben Jackson all my Negroes which I have lent to my Wife Abigail after the Expiration of her Widowhood to be equally divided amongst them and to remain to them and their heirs or assigns forever;

Item I give all my Stock of Horses, Cattle and Hogs and all my Household and Kitchen furniture which I have lent to my Wife Abigail after the Expiration of her Widowhood to my four Sons to wit, Ephraim Jackson, Woody Jackson, Ambrose Jackson and Reuben Jackson to be Equally Divided amongst them and to remain to them and their heirs or assigns forever;

My Will is that if my Wife Abigail Jackson shall not stand to and abide by this

Item I give to my Son Ambrose Jackson one Negroe Girl named Charlott and her increase to him and his heirs or assigns forever; -

Item I give to my son Reuben Jackson one Negroe Girl named Judah & her increase to him and his heirs or assigns forever; -

Item I give to my five Sons to wit, Benedict Jackson, Ephraim Jackson, Woody Jackson, Ambrose Jackson and Reuben Jackson all my Negroes which I have lent to my Wife Abigail after the Expiration of her Widowhood to be equally divided amongst them and to remain to them and their heirs or assigns forever; -

Item I give all my Stock of Horses, Cattle and Hogs and all my Household and Kitchen furniture which I have lent to my Wife Abigail after the Expiration of her Widowhood to my four Sons to wit, Ephraim Jackson, Woody Jackson, Ambrose Jackson and Reuben Jackson to be Equally Divided amongst them and to remain to them and their heirs or assigns forever; -

My Will is that if my Wife Abigail Jackson doth not stand to and abide by this my Will but chases and takes any thing else in preference there in that case I give to my Son William Parish Jackson all that part of my estate

which I have before given to my five sons to wit, Benedict Jackson, Ephraim Jackson,

Hoody Jackson, Ambrose Jackson, & Newton Jackson except the sum of five shillings
specie each, and to remain to him the said William Parish Jackson his heirs or
Assigns forever.

Lastly I constitute, leave and appoint my three sons to wit William Parish

Jackson, John Jackson, Benedict Jackson my whole & sole Exors. to execute

this my last Will and Testament and I do by these presents make void all &

every other Will or Wills made by me or for me heretofore. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this nineteenth day of

October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty Nine.
