do make and devise this my last will and Testament in manner and form following
Item I give and bequeath to my son William Buford all my Land lying on the south side of
great Whitestone Creek, it being the plantation Snow live on with all the Appurtenances
thereon to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son James Buford all that tract of my Land lying on the
North side of great Whitestone Creek, known by the name of Flatrock, with all the Appurtenances
thereon to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Henry Buford my tract of Land in Lawrenceburg County
containing one hundred Acres more or less to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Francis Keatt and her husband James Keatt the sum
of Fifty pounds specie to them and their heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Letitia Buford my negro man to him and
his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Gabriel Buford one set of Archbishop Tellotons
Works in three Volumes, to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to William Vollenstine twelve hundred weight of Inspected
Crop Tobacco to be paid to him as my Executors hereafter named may
see that he stands in need of, for Cloathing or other necessaries and so to his
heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath the Remainder part of my Estate to my Daughter Letitia
Vollenstine

Wrote in three Volumes, to him and his Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to William Volentine twelve hundred weight of Inspected
Coop Tallow to be paid to him as my Executors hereafter named, may
see, that he stands in need of, for Cloathing or other necessities and so to his
Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath the Remainder part of my Estate to my Daughter Letitia
Ragsdale to her and her Heirs

My will and desire is that my Estate may not be Appraised nor any Inventory returned
to Court, nor any security required of the Executors Lastly I nominate and appoint
my two sons William Buford and James Buford to be my whole and sole executors
to this my Last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have written and
my hand and seal this first Day of February 1791
