

In the name of God. Amen. I Henry Dennis of the County of Nottoway being of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the following manner. I promise My will and desire is that if possible my estate be kept together unsold till all my just debts are paid and as soon as they are discharged that my negro man Flood receive his freedom and four years thereafter to be allowed out of my estate as sufficiency to support ^{him} in Common diet and Cloathing during the remainder of his life the said allowance to be paid to him yearly. Item I give and bequeath all the remainder of my estate of every kind both real and personal to be equally divided between my two brothers John West Dennis and Francis Dennis to them and their heirs forever, but that the said division shall not take place till after the full discharge of my debts aforesaid. Lastly I constitute and appoint my brothers aforesaid, whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament.
