Them My Will and desire is that if either of my sons return from
the said Hospital and my Daughter Mary Farnum should
return to this Country then I give and bequeath all my Estate
to my said Daughter to her and her heirs forever.

Lastly If neither ^{of} my said sons returns from the said Hospital
nor my said Daughter to this Country then my Will
and desire is that the Money arising from the sale
of my Estate shall remain in the hands of my Executor
to do with as he shall think proper, I do hereby Con-
stitute and appoint my Friend William Coyer my whole

Money from the sale of my Estate to him at the discretion of my
Executor to him and heirs forever.

Item My Will and desire is that if neither of my sons return from
the said Hospital and my Daughter Mary Fanning should
return to this Country then I give and bequeath all my Estate
to my said Daughter to her and her heirs forever.

Lastly If neither ^{of} my said sons returns from the said Hospital
nor my said Daughter to this Country then my Will
and desire is that the Money arising from the sale
of my Estate shall remain in the hands of my Executor
to do with as he shall think proper, I do hereby Con-
stitute and appoint my Friend William Coger my whole
and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
also it is my Will and desire that my Estate be not
