Moring, One Cow & calf, I live my loving Wife Lucy Baldwin during
her Widowhood or untill my son Pleasant Baldwin arrives at the Age of

twenty one years, the remainder of my Estate both in doors and without

consisting of the plantation & land I live on Negroes - Stock of all

kinds & and then all except my Land to be Equally divided between my
 Wife Lucy Baldwin my sons John Baldwin Henry Baldwin, William Baldwin
 and my daughters Nancy Baldwin, Sally Moring Wife of Uyas Moring,
 Rebecca Baldwin, Patty Baldwin & Prudence Baldwin, to them and their
 heirs forever. I give to my son Pleasant Baldwin when he arrives at the
 age of Twenty one years half of my Land - the plantation with the
 other half I give to my s^d Son Pleasant at the death of my s^d Wife to him
 and his heirs forever. my desire is that if any of my children die before
 they come in possession of their lot, that it shall go to my daughter -
 Patty Baldwin & her heirs forever, And lastly I do Appoint my friends
 George Baldwin & Henry Farley Ex^{rs} of this my last Will and Testament
 in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 29th day
 of July 1791
