to him and his heirs forever I give and Bequeath unto Mary Wills one Negro
girl vizt. Darcus to her and her heirs forever I give ^{Bequeath} unto my Mother
Elizabeth Wills one Negro vizt. Dinah to her heirs and assigns forever
I give and Bequeath unto my Brother William Worsham all my Land in
Kottoway County and Sitewise my Stone Plantation in Amelia County and all my
Negroes not yet mentioned and all my Stock of horses Cattle Sheep and Hogs
houses household and kitchen furniture and plantation utensels to him and his
heirs and assigns forever My will and Desire is that my Estate be
not Appraised I do appoint my Brother William Worsham whole and sole
Executor to this my Last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal This 5th day of November 1794
