In the name of God amen. I Lawrence Brown of the county of Wiltshire & parish afore-
said being very weak in body, but strong in mind and memory (thanks be to God for it)
and calling to mind the mortality of the body I thought fit to make this my last will & Testament
as follows to wit. Item I give unto my Grandson Joseph Brown son and heir of my son Thomas
Brown dec^d One half my lane whereon I now live being the upper part of the tract, where my son
Thomas lived to him and his heirs forever. I give unto my Grandchildren that is the children
of my son Thomas Brown dec^d to wit. Joseph, Martha, Lemuel, Judith, Sarah, Sarah, and Thomas
Brown the following Slaves to wit Phillis, Solly, Bob, Scipio, Moses, & Abraham to be equally
divided between the above S^d Children which said negroes and their increase I give unto the above
named children and their heirs forever. Whereas I have sold two negroe boys the children
of the above named Phillis to wit Toney to Richard Smith Lewis to Henry Baldwin and
have rec^d full satisfaction for the two Slaves and appearing since that the right of the above boys
is disputable therefore my will is that in case the right appears not to be good then my Will
is that the remainder part of my land being the lower part shall be sold together with
all my stock and furniture for the best price that can be got - and the money arising from the
sale thereof to be applied to wards the Sums of Money Rec^d of the said Smith & Baldwin as far as
it will go. Should there be any money in hand after paying the demands above, then my
will is that my executor hereafter mentioned shall pay the same to my son Esquire Brown
with five Shillings Sterling which I give to him and his heirs forever. My will is that in case
the said Richard Smith and Henry Baldwin should find the right in the S^d Slaves to be lost to

gives up the said Slaves or are compelled to do so then my will is that they shall be equally divided with the rest of my Slaves to the within mentioned Children of Thomas Brown and to them & their heirs forever. I do appoint & constitute Rowland Ward Junr and Littlebury Royall my lawful Executors... annulling and making Void all wills heretofore written as Witness my hand and seal this Twenty fifth day of November One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine

Walloway County Court Sept. 11th 1794 This will and Testament of Lawrence Brown deceased was proved by the oath of John Gooch a witness thereto. and at a Court held for the said County at the courthouse on Thursday the 7th of Sept 1794 This will was further proved by the oath of John Harrison a witness thereto and is now ordered to be recorded, and on the Motion of Mr Gooch a certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration with this will annexed he having taken the oath of an Adminr with the will annexed and with Abraham Hatched his Security entered into & acknowledges a bond according to Law
