of our Lord 1802 I New Clark of Nottoway County being in a low state of health but in
perfect tranquillity and soundness of Mind do make Constitute and ordain this my
Last Will and Testament. First I recommend my Soul in to the hands of my blessed
Saviour and my Body to be Buried in a Christian like manner and as to my worldly
Property and Estate, both real and personal I dispose of in the following manner
To wit, I lend unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Clark all my Tract of Land where we now
live with all the appertinances, With all my Household & Kitchen furniture, —
Plantation Utensils With all and Every Species of my Property during her Natural life
Then I Give unto my said Wife Elizabeth Clark all my wearing clothes to her & her heirs forever
Then After the decease of my said Wife I Give and bequeath my said tract of Land & Planta-
tion With the appertinances to be Equally divided between my Brother William
Clark and my Brother in law Charles Wilson of Nottoway County to them their heirs
& assigns I Give and bequeath unto my said Wife's Nephew Featherston With to each to be paid
him or his heirs by those unto whom I Will my share each one to pay an equal
part to him & his heirs forever
Then I Give and bequeath unto my said Wife's Nephew William Vaughan to each to be
paid him as above mentioned to Featherston With to him the said W^m Vaughan and
his heirs forever

Paul to him & his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my said Wifes Asphew William Vaughan to each to be paid him as above mentioned to Featherston Wills to him the said Wm Vaughan and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my Mice Lucy Spain to each to be paid Her or Her Heirs as above mentioned to Featherston Wills to Her or Her Heirs forever

Then After the decease of my Wife I give and bequeath unto my Brother W^m Clark My Brother in law Burrell Featherston & My Brother in law Charles Wilson all my Slaves & their increase to be equally divided between them the said W^m Clark Burrell Featherston & Charles Wilson to them and their Heirs forever My Will and desire is that such division be made without any sale of said Negroes or Slaves

Then after the decease of My said Wife I give and bequeath unto My Brother in law Burrell Featherston and My friends and Neighbour John Jones, preacher of Nottoway County all my Household and Kitchen furniture stock of all kinds with all and every species of my Property not Will'd away to be equally divided between them the said Burrell Featherston & John Jones Preachers to them and their Heirs forever My Will and desire is that all such division

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 I make of Conveyance of my said property and order Mr. Burwell
 and Mr. Featherston (John Jones) Preacher as Executors of this My last
 Will & Testament removing everything I own and all my debts by the same
 and by these presents confirm and establish this to be my last Will in Writing
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this day & year above Written
