equally divided among all Mary's Children to them & their heirs forever Item I lend to my Daughter
Elizabeth Ellis during her life one Negro Girl named Lucy with her increase & at her Death
I give the 3^d & Negro Lucy & her increase to be equally divided among all Elizabeth's Children to
them & their heirs forever Item I lend to my Daughter Christiana Bennett during her life
one negro girl named Adey with her increase & at her Death I give the 3^d Negro Adey &
her increase to be equally divided among all Christiana's Children & their heirs forever, Item
I give to my Daughter Dicey Waller a good Riding Horse Feather Bed & Furniture, two Cows
Calves four hogs two six knives and Forks six Spoons one Sow & pigs, six powder
kettles rich & Bacon to be to her heirs forever Item I give my Daughter Dicey Waller
during her life one Negro Girl named Chloe with her increase & at her Death I give the 3^d
& Negro Chloe & her increase to be equally divided among all Dicey's Children & their heirs
forever Item I give to my son John Waller one Negro named Gram now in his possession

forever. Item I give to my son John Walter one Negro named Sam now in his possession
and his heirs forever. Item I give to my son William Walter the Sum of Sixty
pounds Cash which he has now in his possession & at his mothers Death, two Negroes named
Peter & Mary to be valued by two men, & when value I order him to pay & his Brother
John Walter have the money then I give Peter & Mary to my son William Walter &
his heirs forever. Item I give to my son Hampton Walter one third of the Land I do now
possess by John Bellinas. Bulls & Harston Greens one Cow & calf four breeding & as I a
negro man named Charles after the Death of my wife or her widowhood to him & his heirs forever
Item I give unto my son Wm Walter another third part of my Land lying on each Side
of Little Creek adjoining John Southes & Harston Green & one Negro Boy named Robin
two cows & calves four breeding two one Sow & Pigs one Feather Bed & Furniture to him & his
heirs forever. Item I give unto my son Major Walter the other third part of my Land it
being the part where I now live adjoining John Southes Lish Bolting my son Hampton
& Garret Walter with one Negro named John one Feather Bed & Furniture two Cows & calves
four breeding two one Horse valued at eight pounds, one Sow & Pigs to him & his lawful Heirs
& no body if no lawful Heirs of his body my will is that it shall be divided between
my Sons Hampton & Garret & to them & their heirs forever. Item I lend to ^{my} beloved wife
Elizabeth during her natural life or widowhood my Land & plantation whereon I
now live with 5 Negroes named Peter, Mary, named Charles, Sally & their increase,

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Peter & Mary to be taken in two men, & when I shall order him to pay Ann his Brother
John Miller half the money then I give Peter & Mary to my son William Baker &
his heirs forever. Item I give to my son Hampton Waller one third of the land & negro
valued by John Billings. Sails & Marston Greens & one cow & calf four breeding & as I a
negro man named Charles after the death of my wife or her widowhood to him & his heirs forever
Item I give unto my son Major Waller another third part of my land lying on each side
of Little Creek adjoining John Boulkas & Marston Green & one negro Boy named Robin
two sows & calves four breeding two one Sow & Pigs one Feather Bed & Furniture to him & his
heirs forever. Item I give unto my son Major Waller the other third part of my land it
being the part where I now live adjoining John Boulkas Little Bottom my son Hampton
& Garret Waller with one negro named John one Feather Bed & Furniture two Cows & Calves
four breeding two one Heir valued at eight pounds, one sow & Pigs to him & his lawful Heir
if no lawful Heir of his body my will is that it shall be divided between
my Sons Hampton & Garret & to them & their heirs forever. Item I lend ^{my} beloved wife
Elizabeth during her natural life or widowhood my land & plantation whereon I
now live with 5 Negroes namely Peter, Mary, named Charles, Sally, & their increase
with all my Household & Kitchen Furniture Horses Cattle Sheep & Hogs &c. with
the rest of my estate except what I have already given as above during her natural

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life or widowhood but if the marriage of my Son Hampton shall take Charles & all I have given
my Son Major to maintain my Son Major untill he comes of age & at the Death of my wife
my Will is that what I have lent her except what I have already given as above, shall be equally
divided among all my Children namely Susanna, Parham Mary Buford, Elizabeth Ellis Christiana
Bennet; Dicey Waller; John Waller William Waller, Hampton Waller, Garrod Waller &
my Son Major Waller; to them & their Heirs forever I have I constitute my beloved Wife
Elizabeth Waller my Executrix, & my Sons William & Hampton Waller Executors, to this
my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking & disannulling all other Wills, heretofore
made by me either in Word or Writing & I do acknowledge this to be my last Will, and
Testament.
