I Margaret Hatchett of Amelia County, being in perfect mind and Memory and knowledge that it is appointed for all flesh once to die do make this my last Will and Testament, and as touching my worldly goods I dispose of them in the following manner Viz

Imprimis I Will that my estate be not appraised.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Thomson her heirs &c Two shillings for her full part of my estate.

Item I give and bequeath to the Heirs of my Daughter Mary Marshall ac^d Two shillings as their full part of my Estate

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Hatchett his heirs and assigns one Negro man named Bob.

My Will and desire is that my two beds Household & Kitchen

Furniture and what little Stock I have should be sold at twelve

Months Credit and the Money arising from thence together with what

Item I give and bequeath to the Heirs of my Daughter Mary Marshall
and Two shillings as their full part of my Estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Hatchett his heirs and assigns
one Negro man named Bob.

My will and desire is that my two beds Household & Kitchen
Furniture and what little Stock I have should be sold at twelve
Months Credit and the Money arising from thence together with what
Money I have owing to me and also on hand before the raising the
following Legacies the sum of Fifty pounds I give to be divided among
my three grand Children Viz David Neal Thomas Neal and
Sabitha Neal in the following manner. The two boys to have
Fifteen pounds each and the remainder to the Girl. I also give One
Hundred pounds of the same Money to be equally divided between
my Daughter Martha Roberts and my son William Hatchett their
Heirs or assigns.

Item I gave and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Truly all my wearing apparel

From I give and bequeath to my son Archer Hatchet his Nevers and assigns
Two Negro boys named George and Probert.

I give and bequeath to my son Abraham Hatchett his heirs and assigns my three Negroes named Hal, Ben, and Effy and also all the remaining part of my estate be it in whatever kind or quality.

Item I Will that nothing herein contained be misconstered for want
of form or form in law, and I do hereby constitute and appoint my
son Abraham Waterell the sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament, In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and
seal the day and year first above written.
