 of my wearing apparel together with all my sister Fanny's clothing
 likewise one feather bed and furniture one flowered earthen dish
 half dozen plates and half dozen cups and Saucers, Now the
 remainder of my estate of whatsoever kind it be I give unto the
 said Peggy Stow and my brother John Stow his paying all
 charges arising from this writing I leave Abra. Stow and
 Fanny Davis Executors of this my last Will and Testament
 and in confirmation of the whole I have set my hand &
 seal
