Item I give to my three sisters Hannah Anderson Rebecca Anderson & Lucy Anderson a certain horse given me by Peter Robinson for the sum of Ninety nine pounds 8th bearing date the first day of November 1779 Eight which bond was for Tobacco sold s^r Robinson which Tobacco it is thought belongs

to my three sisters aforesaid by Virtue of the will of my late husband I have my dec^d to be equally divided amongst them as soon as the money can be collected. Item I give to my brother William Anson one feather bed and furniture to him & his heirs or assigns forever. Item I give to my brother in Law Peter Hawks my brogs out. Now Item my will and desire is that my Executors shall as soon

as possible purchase a young negro man to be paid for out of my estate which negro I lend to my father and mother to work for them as long as they live and after their death I give said Negro to my brother William Anderson to have and his heirs or assigns forever. Item I give to my two sisters Polly B Echols and

Item I give to my two sisters Polly B. Ecker and Sally Harper all the residue of my estate after all my Just debts are paid to be Equally divided between them their heirs &c. Item lastly I constitute leave and appoint my two friends William C. Ecker and Herman Harper my sole Executors to execute ^{this} my last will and testament, and I do hereby make void and revoke all and every other will or wills made by me or for me.
