~~Notoway~~ ^{and State of Virginia} do make, ordain and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following. It is my will that my
beloved wife Sabina may ^{have} keep and enjoy all the estate I have both
real and personal of every kind for and during the ^{term} of her life
without any appraisement or inventory thereof being taken during
her life. And after the death of my said wife I give to my nephew
Joel Tucker (son of my brother Matthew Tucker) all my lands to him
and his heirs forever. Should my two female negroes have any children
before the death of my said wife, it is my Will that two thirds of
such children may be allotted to my aforesaid nephew Joel Tucker
which I give to him and his heirs forever. And the said two
female

164 female negroes (to wit) Mary and Annora with one third of their increase
at the death of my wife I give to my Niece Sally Eckles (daughter of
Edw. Eckles) and at the death of my said wife my Will is that the balance
of my estate not already specifically given, be equally divided between
aforesaid Stephen Joel Tucker and my aforesaid Niece Sally Eckles, all of
which legacies are given to them and their heirs forever. I do hereby ap-
point my wife Tabitha and my friend Freeman Eckles to execute this
my last Will and Testaments In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
