I give and Bequeath unto my nephew Philip Greenhill Williams, Son of my Sister Williams when he comes to the age of Twenty one years old or married Two Negroes Peter son of Sue's and Fanny a girl to him and his heirs forever - but if my nephew Philip Greenhill Williams dies before he comes to the age of Twenty one years old or married then I give and Bequeath the above Two Negroes Peter and Fanny to the eldest surviving Son of my Sister Williams to him and his heirs forever - Item I give and Bequeath unto my Mother Catharine Greenhill all the Real and Personal Estate of what nature or Quality soever, either real or personal, during her natural life and no longer Item I give and Bequeath after my Mother's death unto my Brother Samuel Greenhill all the above Estate that I give to my Mother - during her natural Life consisting of Land, Negroes, Stock &c it being all the remainder and residue of my Estate both Personal and Real to him and his heirs forever and Lastly I desire my will may not be dispensed and do constitute and appoint my Mother Catharine Greenhill an Executrix and my Brother Samuel Greenhill an Executor to this my last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal the day and year first written Signed Sealed & Delivered by the same Philip Greenhill to be
