

In the name of God amen I Richard Ramsey of the County and parish of Chertoway being of sound mind and memory, and also sensible of the uncertainty of human life, do make and assign this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all former wills heretofore made by me viz. My will and desire is that my land whereon I now live be divided according to the sum it cost me $\text{\pounds}$ acre between my two sons Booker and Terel in the following manner viz. — beginning at the upper corner on the Sagaretta creek thence down the said creek so far as that a straight line to be run from the said creek out to Cokers line on the road will leave that part of the said tract lying to the west and on which my son Booker's house now stands to be less valuable than the other part by forty six pounds which said part on the west side of the tract, and the least valuable, I give to my son Booker to him and his heirs forever and the other part adjoining James Hendersons Glebe land and on which my dwelling house now stands I give to my wife during her life and at her death to go to my son Terel to him and his heirs forever. Item I give to my wife during her ^{three} natural life the following negroes, to wit, Milley Mingo the br Sam together with all my stock of Horses cattle Sheep and Hogs, and at her death to be equally divided between my two sons Booker and Terel to them and their heirs forever. Item the rest of my Slaves I will to be equally divided between my said two sons Booker and Terel, to them and their heirs forever. It is my further will and desire that if my son Terel should ever intermarry with Susanna Mainford, then and in that case all the estate of every kind whatsoever

their heirs forever. It is my further will and desire that if my son Terel should ever marry with Susanna Munford, then and in that case all the estate of every kind whatsoever herein given and devised to him the said Terel shall be forfeited and go to my son Booker, to him and his heirs forever except the sum of five shillings. It is my desire that neither of my said sons shall give away any of the property herein given and devised to them respectively. Lastly I nominate and appoint James Henderson and my son Booker Executors to this my last will and Testament to whose discretion and direction I leave the payment of all my just debts.
