I Samuel Pincham of Halloway County do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows (Vizt) I leave my wife Sophia Pincham during her widowhood all the tract of land I purchased of John Rayall (being the land I live on) except that part of the woodland lying South of the path leading from the road near the upper corner of William Pinchams old field to the ford across Celler creek opposite James Clarks. Item my will and desire is that the new dividing line between the lands of William Pincham and myself be extended from the place it strikes the road in its present course till it strikes the old line lying west of the upper part of the land I purchased of John Rayall and that all the land south of the said new line and between the said old line and the road up to the lines of Matthew Ward be equally divided in two parts by a line to be run parallel with the aforesaid old line one moiety thereof (to wit) the part which lies adjoining the road I give to my brother William Pincham and his heirs forever. Item I give to my friend Peter Randolph five pounds for the purpose of purchasing a ring to be worn in memory of me, Item I give devise and bequeath all the remaining part or parts of my estate of every kind and denomination whatsoever including the land will'd to my wife at her death or marriage

to my daughter and her heirs for ever and should she depart this life before
at lawful age or marry. I Give devise and bequeath all the aforesaid estate to my
brother William Pincham and his heirs forever. Lastly, I constitute and appoint him
the said William Pincham executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of November one thousand seven hundred
and ninety seven
