Tobacco, Corn, Godden and Wheat.

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mary Sampson one
Cow & calf and also my side Saddle.

Item I give and devise to my Son John Leath the sum of Five
Shillings to be Raised and paid out of my Estate at the Discre-
tions of my Executors, I do make Constitute and Appoint John
Leath and James Gregg Executors of this my last Will and
