make constitute & appoint this to be my last will & Testament in man-
ner and form following Viz —
after all my just debts are paid I give and dispose of my Estate as
follows

Item I lend to my loving wife Betty Walker the whole of my Estate
both real and personal during her life or widowhood and at her death to dispose
of one half of the land I now live on as she thinks proper also at the
death of my wife my desire is that the whole of my stock of horses Cattle hogs
& sheep be sold & divided between my Children Thomas Walker Henry
Walker Richard Walker Mary Jones Betty Sammons Susannah Hooper
Barbara Williams Patsy Wood & John Walkers Children —

Item I give to my Daughter Susannah Hooper one half of the land I now
live on when divided for her to take her choice to her & her heirs
forever

Item I give the other half of my Land to my Grandson Allen Walker
to him and his heirs forever —

my will is that my wife Betty Walker shall dispose of all my
household furniture at her death as she thinks proper
Item my desire is that all the negroes that I have let my Children have
in their possession to be theirs with their future increase them and
their heirs forever —

Item I give to my son Richard Walker my negroe man named

of one half of the land I now own
at death of my wife my desire is that the whole of my stock of horses cattle my
& sheep be sold & divided between my Children Thomas Walker Henry

Barbara Williams Patty Wood & John Walker's Children -

Item I Give to my Daughter Susannah Hooper one half of the land I now
own on when divided for her to take her choice to her & her heirs
forever

I Turn I give the other half of my Land to my Grandson Allen Walker
He him and his heirs forever -

My will is that my wife Betty Walker shall dispose of all my
Household furniture at her death as she thinks proper
Item My desire is that all the negroes that I have let my Children have
in their possession to be theirs with their future increase them and
their heirs forever

Item I Give to my son Richard Walker my negro man named
Reubin to him and his heirs forever

Item My Will and Desire is that all the negroes that I now have & that
given with their future increase at my & my wife's death be equally
divided between my Children Viz - Henry Walker Richard Walker
Mary Jones Betty Sammons Susannah Hooper Barbara Williams
Patty Wood and the Children of John Walker due to them and
their heirs forever

Lastly I appoint my beloved sons Thomas Walker and Richard
Walker Executors to this my last Will & Testament in

At a Court held for & between County on Thursday the 6th day of June
1793 This last will & testament of Thomas Walker dec'd was exhibited into

bond with Security as the law directs Certificate is granted him to
