In the name of God Amen this 11th day of April 1865
 I William Bailey of Walloway County and State of Virginia being
 very sick & infirm of body but of sound mind & disposing memory do make
 constitute & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in the manner & form
 following to wit, I purport I will that all my just debts be paid, Item
 I have been informed that my Uncle Christopher Murray hath sold a tract
 of land for me by my request lying in the County of Baltimore State
 of Maryland which I inherited from my father and my said Uncle not
 being empowered to convey a right for the same therefore my Will

to convey all the rights title interest claim and annuity that I have to the
said land to the person who has purchased the same. Item I will that
my Executor sell all my right to the mill which is now proposed by my
-self and Nathaniel Foulkes the said Foulkes being entitled to one fourth of
the mill and one fourth of the privilege of the same and myself the balance
and also that my Executor sell all the residue of my land which I am now
proposed of in ~~Howe~~ ^{Howe} County and that he convey a right to the purchaser
for the same, and if after the sale of the above property there should not
be a sufficiency for the discharge of my debts, then I will that my Ex-
-ecutor shall sell any part of my estate that he thinks can be best spared
to supply that deficiency. All the residue of my estate (after paying
my just debts) both real and personal. I will should be kept together on my
land that lies in Prince Edward County under the control of my Executor
for the support of my wife during her widowhood, and for the schooling &
support of my daughter Rebecca & Bailey in her minority. If my daugh-
-ter should marry before my wife ceases to be my widow or if my wife should
marry before my daughter becomes of age or marries, then
that my wife shall have one

that my wife shall have one third part of the Tract of Land lying in Prince
Edward County, also one third part of all the personal estate to her & her heirs
forever. And the whole of the residue I give to my daughter Rebecca E
Bailey to her and her heirs forever, but if my said daughter Rebecca E
