beginning at west Creek my wife Mary Dyson to have the

upper part leaving Mares land Middle the slaves as

follows Charles Phelps - Bayly addition of Phoe with one

third part of my Stock of all kind also one third part

of my household & Kitchen Furniture but since my wife shoud

many Phoe & Adelorn to be returned to my Exrd and he

equally divided my Children hereafter mentioned

Thirdly I give unto my son Francis Dyson the tract

of land purchased of Stephen Holt to him and his heirs

for ever also one negro woman slave by the name of George

Surely I give unto my son Thomas Dyson the heirs, part of the land
of Land I Purchased of Thos G Peckham to him and his heirs forever
the upper Part of the said tract of land, but to my wife after
her death I give the child my wife is now pregnant with if a
male belongeth to him and his heirs forever if a daughter I give
her said land to my daughter Dyson to her & her heirs forever

Fifthly I Give unto my Daughter Mary Winfree Meany and her child
whomever she shall have at the time of her marriage or house where she dwelle and
one hundred & fortynine shillings of my Sons die before they arrive
to the age of 21 Years or many less land is to be equally divided
between my sons leaving of two if one to him and his heirs
forever.

Sixtly The residue of my Es^c m^t not yet mentioned
in my Will to equally divided between the issue of my children
as they arrive to the age of 21 Years or more Except Mary Winfree
who has one half free Proportion of my Es^c already.

Seventy I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary
Dyson Es^c or my son Francis Dyson with my son Daniel
Vassal Col^r to their my last will and testament in witness of
