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In the name of God Amen I Zachariah Holland of the Parish and County of Malloway being weak & low in health, and calling to mind the uncertainty of this mortal life, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following, vizt.

Imprimis, I give & devise unto Nancy Davis my Feather bed & furniture, in consideration of her attendance on me during my indisposition.

Item I give and devise unto my three Nieces, Ellenor Thompson, Barbary Thompson and Mary Thompson Children of my sister Judith Thompson deceased, to be equally divided amongst them my stock of Horses, Cattle & Hogs; all my House hold & Kitchen furniture, (except my Bed & furniture devised to Nancy Davis) also all my plantation tenents, and my Negroe Man Slave Dick, to them & their heirs forever; but it is my Will & Desire that Dick be hired out by my Executors herein after appointed, annuallly, until my niece Barbary Thompson shall come of age or marry, at which time he shall be divided, together with the money arising from his hire between the said before mentioned Ellenor, Barbary & Mary or the survivors of them.

Item It is my will & desire that my Executors herein after appointed shall sell, on such terms as they may think most proper, my Land whereon I now live, and that the money arising from the sale thereof be equally divided between my said before mentioned Nieces Ellenor, Barbary and Mary. But it is my Will & desire that in case that either of my & said Nieces Ellenor, Barbary or Mary should die before they come of age or marry, that their proportion of my estate as herein before devised shall be equally divided between the survivors of them.

Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my friends William Gray & Freeman Epes Executors of this my last will & testament, hereby revoking & disannulling all former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 22nd day of May 1751.
