John Frazier Eldest Son William Frazier when he comes of age Viz
I give and bequeath to Tebulon Lewis one plough trace & bullock hoe
one reeding hoe one W. hammers and Traces & two blue jackets one Duff
and one Gambelet Viz. I Desire that John Frazier may have all the
rest of my moveable effects Viz. I give and bequeath unto Isaac
George my mare & Dr. Viz And my Old Saddle and Bridle I Desire
that Tebulon Lewis may have them I Desire that Isaac George

And Robert Dawson maybe the Executors of ^{the} will of
Here and to I set my hand and Seal this 27 day of April in the
Year of our Lord God 1771

At a Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 29 day of May 1771
This Last Will and Testament of Alexander Frazer Deceased was presented
into Court by Isaac George & Robert Dawson Executors therein named
and proved by the Oaths of Daniel Lambert & Killy Bramham
two of the witnesses thereto and Ordered to be Recorded and on the motion
of the said Executors who made Oath according to Law Certificates
granted them for obtaining Probate thereof in due form they
giving Bond & Security for the same whereupon they with Jacob
Williams their security Entered into Bond for the same in the
Sum of £100
