Ex^{or} hereafter named shall think fit nothing doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty Power of God
and as Touching my worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me
in this life I dispose of the same in the following Manner and form
Item I give and Bequeath to my two Sons Edward Smith and John Smith the
Land whereon I live being one hundred and fifty Acres to be equally
Divided between them and to their Heirs forever after I am to be buried
My Well Beloved Wife Anne Smith during her life and Widowhood and after her
Decease what Remains to be Equally divided between my two sons which as
before named I also make and Ordain my Well Beloved Wife Ann Smith

make and Ordain my Well beloved Wife Ann Smith
Will and Testament and I do hereby Disallow all other Wills and Testaments
I in witness hereof have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and
date first above written. Sealed and Delivered by the said Ambrose Smith
as his last Will and Testament in the Presence of

A Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 26th of April 1770
This last Will and Testament of Ambrose Smith Deceased was produced
and was proved by the oath of Roger Bottom one of the Witnesses thereto and Ordered to be Recorded and
on the Motion of the said Executor who made oath according to Law
Certificate is granted her for obtaining of Letters of Probate thereof in due
form the giving security wheredpon the said Ambrose Smith further
Security is taken into Bond for the same in the sum of £100.
