In the name of God amen I Dyakon Vice of the
County of Orange being in perfect
sound mind and memory do hereby therefore given to Almighty
God do I the said and obtain this my Last will and Testament in
manner and form following that is to say first and principally
I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping
for glorious resurrection at the Last day and my body I commit
to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of
my Executors hereafter named and touching the disposition
of such Personal Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me

I give and bequeath in manner and form as follows viz I leave
to my Loving wife Jeger Price my Two Negroes Mary Will and my Malt Horse
Mary M. I leave as also I leave my said wife my Tract of Land at the old office
to her During her Natural Life also it is my Will that my Executors hereafter
named do Immediately after my Decease have Built for my said wife on the
aforesaid Land a good Dwelling house Twenty feet long and sixteen feet
Wide a Smoke house eight feet square and a milk house twelve feet long
and eight feet wide and it is my Will and Desire that my said wife live on
my now Dwelling Plantation until the above Buildings are Completed and
Finished Then I give and bequeath unto my Son William Price my negro
Winch named Jada now in his Possession one Cow and calf one two year old
then one four head of Hogs sold to him and his heirs. Then I give &
bequeath unto my six grand Children viz Francis Wm. Cary Mary Joseph
and Betty Crump Children of my Daughter Mary Crump Deceased the following
Negro viz Mary Sarah and Moses now in their Father's Possession
and their Inheritance to be equally divided Between them as soon as my said
Daughter Betty Crump arrives to sixteen years of Age or day of a Marriage
To them and their heirs Then I give and bequeath unto my Two Sons Augustus
and John the sum of \$1000 each to be paid to them when they arrive to the age of 21 years

To them and their heirs. Then I give and bequeath unto my two sons, ^{Price} ~~Price~~ and John Price the Tract of Land ^{now} ~~now~~ live on to be Equally Divided Between
them ^{or} ~~or~~ them and their heirs forever. Then It is also my Desire that half an
Acre of this Land be not sold but kept for a Burialling Place for my Family.
Then I give and Bequeath unto my grandson John Hill three my Negro Wench
Sarah to him and his heirs. Then I give and Bequeath unto my grand son
Angaton Price my Negro Man named Will after my Wife's Decease to him and
his heirs. Then I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Green and John
Wing of Fifty Shillings Value With their Portion in Christ and the my Comfort be
A P. to her and her heirs. Then it is my earnest Will and Desire that the my
Wife's Jewels, Rob. Toms, and things which I lent to my Daughter Eliza Green to be
sold by her husband to one David Hemmings be by my Executors Immediately Demanded
and taken into their Possession and if their David Hemmings should refuse to
Deliver up these Negroes to my said Executors When Demanded that then it is
my Desire that my Executors should bring suit for them and when recovered deliver
my Executors may keep these Negroes in their Possession During my Daughter
Eliza's Green's Life and that they apply the Profits of their Labour as they think
Proper towards the Support and Maintenance of my said Daughter and her
children after my said Daughter's Decease. It is my Will and Desire that

The said Negroes, James, Seb, Tom and Mary and their issue to be Equally
Divided Between the Children of my said Daughter Elizabeth Green and
Their heirs. Then I give and Bequeath unto my son John Price an Negro man
named London. Now in his Possession to him and his heirs forever also I
give unto my said son John Price my white Latto Woman named Mary M Intish
after my Wifes Decease to him and his heirs. Then I give and Bequeath unto
my son Richard Price my two Negroes George and Tall and my Negro Child
named Sarah also that Part of my Land at the old office after my Wifes
Death lying on the South Side of the main Road leading to Frederickburg
also one young Male commonly called him and the heirs of his Body
lawfully Begotten forever and for want of such heirs of his Body Lawfully
Begotten as aforesaid then it is my Will and Desire that these Land Negroes
and the Part of his Estate of what Nature or Kind soever be Equally Divided
among all my Children to them and their heirs. Then I give unto my said son
Richard Price after his Mothers Death my Negro Wench named Nan to him
and his heirs. Then I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Catharine Moore

and as been. Then I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Catherine Moore
my three Negroes Adam, Rose & Tibby one Cow and half one two year old
Steer and the Remainder Part of my Old Office Land lying on the north side
of the Road leading to Fredericksburg next to Edward Waller to her and her
heirs forever. Then it is my Will and Desire that all the residue & remainder
of my Estate of What nature or kind soever be Equally Divided Between my Loving
Wife my Son Angolan Price my Son John Price and my Son Richard Price to them &
Their heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Loving Wife
Joyce Price Executrix my Son Angolan Price and my Son John Price Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament touching and making Void all former
and other Will or Wills heretofore by me made In Witness Whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this 29th day of April one Thousand seven
Hundred and Seventy three.

This Last Will and Testament of Nathan Price deceased being presented into Court
by Joyce Price Executrix of Nathan Price and John Price Executors therein named

Witnesses thereto and Ordered to be Recorded and on the motion of the said
Executors who made Oath according to Law Certificate is granted them
For obtaining Probate thereof in due form Whereupon Joyce Price and Nathan
Price with Caleb Soper and Ruben Moore their Executors also John Price
with Joseph Spencer and Uziel Matting his Sureties entered into Acknow-
-ledged their Bonds for the same And Ordered that Nathan Price the heir at Law
be summoned to the next Court to make Objections to this Will if any
he has.
