one thousand seven hundred and thirty Two I Benjamin Case of the County of Orange
Being of good & Perfect memory Thanks be to God do make & Ordain this my Last
my Last Will & Testament in Manner and Form following that is to say first
I Request my Soul and Spirit into the hands of Almighty God my Heavenly
Father by whom of his Merc & only grace I Trust to be Saved & Recieved into Eternal
Rest through the death of our Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ in whose precious
Blood I set the whole & only hope of my Salvation. my Watched Body in hope
of a Joyfull Resurrection I commit to the Earth to be Buried & so Touching the
Distribution of my mortal Goods I dispose of the same as followeth
First I Give all my House & plantation whereon I now live to my Dear and
Loving Wife Hannah Case during her life & after her Death to my son W^m Case
and his heirs. Then I Give unto my son John Case in Culpeper County one
Hundred & Twenty ^{four} Acres of land in this County to be Sold of from the same

The Back of an Equal width to him & heirs. Then I give unto my son
 Benjamin Cave Two hundred acres of land of the said tract in Calhoun
 County to be laid off at the upper End to him & heirs. Then I give unto my son David
 Cave the remaining part of my land in Meigs County One hundred & seventy eight
 acres of land more or less to him & his heirs. Then I give unto my son William
 Cave my right of a house in this County during their lives. I give unto my
 Wife Hannah Cave four Negroes Viz. Jack, Matt, Luke, Dinah & Burton. During
 her life & after her death to be equally divided among my four sons Benjamin,
 William, David & Rich^d. Cave & my four Daughters Eliza Johnson, Ann Cavender,
 Sarah & Hannah Cave & their heirs & assigns. Then I give unto my son Benjaⁿ
 Cave one negro fellow named Parker to him his heirs & assigns. I give unto
 my son William Cave Two Negroes named Toby & Sam to him his heirs and
 assigns. I give unto my son David Cave Two Negroes named Tom & Milley's
 Wench to him his heirs & assigns. I give unto my son Rich^d Cave Three
 Negroes named Phillis a Wench one Boy named Harry & a Boy named Rob. to
 him his heirs & assigns. I give unto my Daughter Sarah Cave one Negro a
 Wench named Lucy, a Boy named Sam, & a Girl named Jenny to her and her
 heirs & assigns. I give unto my Daughter Hannah Cave Four Negroes named

Juda, Comfy, James & George to her & her heirs & assigns. I give unto my
Daughter Elizabeth Johnson Two Negroes a Wench named Juda & Ray named
Jack to her & her heirs & assigns and finally I give unto my Daughter Ann
Cassiter one Negro wench named Violet to her & her heirs & assigns. As to
my other Estate I give unto my son William Cass one feather bed & furniture
and I give unto my son David Cass one feather bed & Furniture & I give to my
Daughter Sarah Cass a bed & furniture. I give also unto my son David Cass
one young horse named Prince. Also I give unto my son John Cass one
large square Table. Also I give unto my Daughter Hannah Cass one feather
bed & Furniture. I give also unto my son Richd Cass one feather bed &
Furniture and as to the other part of my Estate I commit to my loving wife to
dispose of as she shall think proper & necessary during her widowhood &
I do hereby appoint my loving wife Hannah Cass & my two sons John Cass
& William Cass Executors & Executrix of this my Last will & Testament

And at a Court held for this County on Thursday the 25th day of Nov^r 1862
On the Motion of Wm Case one of the Executors therein named who made Oath according
to Law to perform as granted him for obtaining Letters of probate thereof in due form
giving security on which he with Geo. Taylor the Executor & the Barbour acknowledged
