Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like
& decent manner at the direction of my Executors Nothing doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
By the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate with
which it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give
Devise & Dispose of the same in the following manner
To wit I appoint as my will is that Ebene Goodall my Brother
shall have fifty acres of my Land at the upper end taking
the dwelling house and the money that shall be gathered
over paying my debts I move my will is that the rest of my

Prophet I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian and
I decent manner at the direction of my Executors Nothing doubting
but that the general resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God I as touching such worldly Estate with
which it hath pleased god to bless me with in this life I give

Devise & Dispose of the same in the following manner
First I purpose my will is that John Goodall my Son
shall have fifty acres of my Land at the upland taking
the dwelling house and the money that shall be gathered
over paying my debts - I here my will is that the rest of my

Land shall be equally divided betwixt my three Sisters
Suzannah Dear Margett Goodall Sarah Goodall my Wife's

That the said Margett Goodall shall have my black horse
The part of the Land falling to Suzannah Dear she shall
have it during her life and at her death it shall fall into the
hands of her Son Charles and to his heirs forever of the

When Goodall should be gone without me have lawfully bequeathed of my
own Body there the fifty acres of land given unto him shall be divided
Among three Sisters Equally divided between them. I have my
Will is that Faries Goodall shall have my Coat and Jacket and
Breeches. I have my will is that Richard Goodall shall have
my Carpenter's tools I do hereby constitute & appoint Joseph Davis
My Executor of this my last will and Testament & I do hereby
Disavow Deny & Disavow all and every other former testaments
Wills & Legacies Requests and Executors by me in any ways before
this time made Wills & Legacies ratified and confirmed
this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In
