First I will that my last beloved person George shall be paid his and Discharged and that all my lands and Tenements on Dutch Vassau or otherwise for and to the payment of said Debt and Charges as the remainder of my leg. shall be for the use of my well beloved Daughter Mary I Kennedy for and to her maintenance and schooling her in her & Her only Sonny Esq. shall see care and I Give unto my said Daughter all my right of lands and Tenements fully to be enjoyed by her her heirs and assigns forever but if my said Daughter shall depart this life before she shall attain to the years of one and twenty then in such case she leaving one legitimate issue I will that my lands and Tenements shall be sold and the money arising thereby with the other money must be divided one half for the use of the Church and the Poor of the Parish of which she shall be a legal Resident at the time of her death and the other half to my Esq. and I Order to present any Dispute or suit the Judge of the peace to give me a certificate that she was born the Twenty Eighth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty two 1742 and I hereby constitute and ordain my well beloved father George
