In the Name of God Amen. I Edward Rolon of the County of Orange being sick
and weak but of sound Memory thanks be to God for it do make and Ordain this my last will
and Testament in manner following first I give my Body to be decently buried at the discretion
of my Executors hereafter mentioned and after my Debts and funeral charges is paid I
give my Estate as follows Item I give to my wife my bed and furniture one set dish one
plate one basin two Iron pots and hooks and two frying pans and six head of Cattle
and six hogs. Item I give to Betty Agnewfield and her sister Ann Agnewfield all my
Crop of Corn and Tobacco on the plantation I now live on and likewise I give three head of Cattle
and seven fourteen head of hogs the Corn and Tobacco and hogs to be equally divided
between the sisters Betty and Ann Agnewfield and I do leave my two children Betty and Ann
Agnewfield to John Morgan till they shall arrive to the age of Eighteen years or Married and
I do Ordain John Morgan my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
given under my hand and seal this 23 day of October 1769
