Widow and Relict of Richard Wade Gent. this Eleventh day of December in
The Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy two do make
And Declare that my Last Will and Testament Respecting all other & former
Wills in manner and form following. First I bequeath my soul into the
Hands of Almighty God and my Body to be Buried at the Direction of my
Executors hereafter named and for all my Estate both Real & Personal that
I am now Seized of or that may hereafter come at that time or at the
any time hereafter I give and bequeath the same to my Two Daughters
Elizabeth Wade and Mary Wade and their heirs forever to be equally

Divided Between them But I desire such Division may not take place
until one of my said Daughters shall arrive to the age of Twenty one
years or until one of them shall be Married in the mean time that the Estate
Be kept together for their Joint and Equal Benefit and it is my Will &
Desire that if both my said Daughters shall depart this Life before either
of them arrives to the age of Twenty one and without issue of their or
either of their Bodies then I give and bequeath all my Estate real and
Personal as aforesaid to my two grand Daughters Catherine & Elizabeth
Dangerfields and their heirs forever to be Equally Divided Between
them But it is now the less my intention and I hereby declare my
Will and Desire to be that if either of my said Daughters shall arrive to
The age of Twenty one or if they or either of them before they arrive to Twenty
one shall depart this Life and leave issue alive of their or either of their
Bodies in that or either of those Contingencies I clearly intend my said
Daughters in the last mentioned Clause shall have the whole Estate real &
Personal and not by any means an Estate in fee tail, And Lastly I com-
mend my beloved Son in Law Stephen William Dangerfield Executor of their
wills to Mr. W. and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set
