I bequeath unto my daughter Ann Magdalena also widow one young black
boy with her help.

Secondly

I give unto my daughter Mary also all my lands that as a tract
of land lying between the plantation known as the Upper
plantation and the plantation known as the Lower plantation
also having the same as a tract of land lying between the
plantation known as the Upper plantation and the plantation
known as the Lower plantation and the plantation known as the

And bequeath unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth I give for her
share of the inheritance

Thirdly

I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Henry the sum of five hundred
pounds whatsover (Accepting one red robe with her black belt which
was her gown for my improper use and disposal in my last will as
God shall spare my life and my health in this world but after my decease
then have call to fall to my Grandson Henry the

wife Dorothy during our lives and to find us due food and clothing and
