or die then my will is that my Estate should be sold at Auction &

& give devise & dispose of the same in Manner & form following that is to say

Disavow revoke & disannul all & every other former Wills & Testaments by me
heretofore made & I do hereby constitute & appoint this my last Will and
Testament in Writings whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day

This last Will & Testament of Elizabeth Rhoads dec^d was presented into Court by

Ann Rhoads & Epaphrodites Rhoads Executors therein named & proved by the oaths

of them & of Epaphrodites Rhoads the Witness thereto & ordered to be recorded

& on the Motion of the said Exec^{rs} who made oath according to Law Certificate was

granted them for obtaining probate thereof in due form giving Security whereupon

they with Thomas Rucker their Security Acknowledged their Bond for the same
