Weather Bruce also five Shillings Sterling Here I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza
Said one also five Shillings Sterling Here I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Mary Bush also five Shillings Sterling Here I give and bequeath unto my son John
Bush five Shillings Sterling Here I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel Bush &
Thomas Bush all the Remainder of my Estate to be Equally Divided between them
to have and their Heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint
Philip Bush and Mary Bush to be my whole and sole Executors of my last Will &
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 1st Day
of September 1745
