Month October 18. 1862

In the name of God amen I John Cadet being sick and weak by  
handwriting and handwriting the party of this my life to make  
known and declare to all men and persons following

I promise I have laid my body in the earth to be buried at the direction of my friends  
hereafter named and committed to the mercy of god laying through his name  
and mediation of Jesus Christ my Lord to receive pardon and forgiveness  
of all sins and be admitted to his blessed Kingdom & paradise  
I do also desire it be done to ensure me with heaven and beneath  
in manner hereof following

I give to my wife Elizabeth my wife Mrs. H. M. and her children  
to have and to hold all my estate & lands & goods to be distributed

among them and among their children

I give my wife Elizabeth my wife the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars

Dear Sirs  
I have signified my desire to make my Estate available  
to you and the claimants to my Estate and  
of them should die before they should leave of Age to receive the  
Equally divided Between them during their Lives and  
when I am dead.

Upon my death in the event of my Death bed and the  
heirs but in case he should die before his Comer of Age to receive the  
Money due him in the event of his Death he should be entitled  
to such a sum as to be equally divided among the  
Sons and daughters to be equally divided among the  
Sons and daughters in their Lives.

After the Settlement of my Estate that can be made by my executors  
estate what ever will be Equally divided Between my Sons and  
Daughters after Lawrence Lawrence having done all he can demand  
it will be considered what will be done when my Sons die before  
they come of age and my rule is that Valentine Morgan Jonathan

and John Morgan Jonathan should be equally divided  
between them and the other two Sons should be  
equally divided between them.

Thirty pounds of Tobacco yearly after the Expiration of Five years  
and also by payment my Sons wife and my Son John and Jonathan

and do hereby Revoke all other written Testaments by me before  
made In regard and Conformation whereof I have hereunder set

my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> Day of November AD 1744

At a Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November 1744
