make and ordain this my last Will and Testament first of all I give and bequeath
my soul unto the hands of God that gave it me and my body to the Earth to be
buried in a Christian like Decent Manner according to the Directions of my
executors nothing but at the General resurrection at the last day to receive the
same by the mighty Power of God Secondly I desire that all my Debts may
be paid off and paid by my executors Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my son John
Collins of forty Acres of land for his holding faithfully I bind and my dear beloved wife
Elizabeth Collins his holding faithfully I bind and my dear beloved wife
Elizabeth Collins all the remainder part of my Estate I now have a hundred and
thirty acres of land in the name of my wife Elizabeth I bind and my dear beloved wife
Elizabeth in her present life fifty by four hundred Begrath after my life deceas
or withdrawed to my son Benjamin Collins the upper tract of Land excepting
thirty feet square of a Survey place of exception left over which is to be
taken of of the lower side belonging to the lower tract which is to be
left to the said Benjamin Collins the lower tract which is to be
left to the said Benjamin Collins the upper tract of Land excepting
thirty feet square to it for his and after my life deceas to his son John
Collins the younger son of the said Benjamin Collins

all my Working Tools and all the Money and Goods left me by my
Sheep and all other Household Goods &c for I have left no money
live and Lamb to Elizabeth Alverson Laffly. I have also made out
Nicholas Collins Executor of this my last Will and Testament and he shall
Other Wills hereeto fore made by me. So witness whereof these Testaments

At a Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 16 April 1770

This last Will and Testament of John Collins Decedent was presented into Court
by Nicholas Collins his son named and proved by Mr. Colls & Joseph
Chandler, Abt Bickers & James Alverson three of the Testificie which tended
to be recorded and on the Motion of the said James who made oath according
to laid Certificate is granted him for Obtaining of Probate thereof and the
sum he gives account of his expenses for same Joseph Chandler Abt Bickers & James
Alverson entered into bond on the sum of £100 Test Geo Taylor C.C.
