unto the same John Gray when he shall come to be of the age of Twenty one years  
One saddle horse studly and hardy one Cow horse two cows and calves one  
feather bed and furniture one iron pot on dozen plates three dishes  
and frying pan and what I find dead & living bedding down his surface  
Item I do unto my loving wife Cathrina all the rest of my estate both  
real and personal of what kind or Nature soever and wheresoever it be

urchased of George Stone to him and his heirs forever. I give and bequeath  
unto the same John Gray what he shall come to be of the age of Twenty one Years  
and to his heirs, children and their issue and land having two cows and Calfes one  
Leather bed and furniture one Iron pot on dozen pickers plates three dishes  
one pair of Shears and to his friends dead & living whatsoever his Injuries  
I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Cathrina all the rest of my estate both  
Real and personal of what kind or Nature wherein and wheresoever it be  
for and during the term of his Natural life and from and after his decease  
I will and do give and bequeath the same unto Thomas John Gray and Do-  
herty Consistute and Appoint my loving and lawfull wife Cathrina to be  
my whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament bearing  
all other and former Wills by me made during this only to be my last  
Will and Testament. I do hereby declare that my said wife Cathrina  
shall this tenth day of January anno Domini one thousand seven hundred  
and forty seven night signe and sealed and Published on the presence  
of us who subscribed us. Name and I desire that and any of my testators  
shall be done.

date of May 26th 1748 of her husband John Johnson who die about that  
time and left no issue but up to the time of his death he had
