In the name of Almighty God Amen I do hereby certify that my last will and testament is as follows to wit the first part thereof is as follows

I give my soul to Almighty God who gave it me and do hereby bequeath my life through the Ministry of my Beloved Church to the Church, and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my said Church after my decease

I give to my beloved Brother Goodwin Lightfoot five hundred dollars a Woman named Miss the other a Woman named Dalphin and I give her all my wearing clothes

I give my beloved Sister Mary Lightfoot one hundred dollars and I give her the tract of land and plantation which I will have the tract of land and plantation which I will have together with all the stock of my said estate

I give to my beloved Sister Elizabeth Lightfoot two hundred dollars and I give her the tract of land and plantation which I will have together with all the stock of my said estate

I give to my son Nathan Goodwin Lightfoot two tracts of land one in Orange County the other being the tract of land and plantation which I will have together with all the stock of my said estate
