Body I commit to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named & as to my Temporal Estate I bequeath & dispose of it in the following
Manner & imprints I give & bequeath to my Son James McKeny my great
Bible Item I give & bequeath to John Davis Son of Matthew Davis and Matthew
his wife all my turning tools with the handsaw & grindstone to be kept by his father
till he comes of age safe & secure without distributing them about Item I leave
my Plantation in Caroline County to be sold by my Executors & the one half of
the money I give and bequeath to my Son James McKeny and the other half
to be divided Between Matthew Davis Matthew Davis John Cudung John
Goodall and James Perry Item I give to Matthew Davis my work that
is begun & not finished to finish & take it for his pains Item I give & bequeath
all the rest of my Temporal Estate to my beloved wife to dispose of as she
thinks proper excepting my Coopers tools which I give and bequeath to my
Son in law John Gooden and I hereby constitute & appoint William Bell
& John Cudung my Joint Executors of this my Last Will & Testament & I
do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all former requests & legacies by me
heretofore in any wise left or made & declare that I do not have any

all the rest of my Temporal Estate to my beloved wife to dispose of as she
~~thinks proper~~ excepting my Coopers tools which I give and bequeath to my
Son in Law John Cudon and I hereby constitute & appoint William Bell
& John Cudon my Joint Executors of this my Last Will & Testament & I
do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all former requests & legacies by me
heretofore in any wise left or made declaring this to be my last
Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have set my hand this 17th day
