Weak in body but of sound and Perfect Memory thanks be eternally to God for
the same do make this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form
following, first I recommend my soul to God that gave it trusting by His
mercies that through the Merits of my Beloved Saviour Jesus Christ to
receive full remission and forgiveness of all my sins, my Body I Commit
to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors here after
named

I purpouse I will that after my Decease my Loving wife Mary Willmet do live and Continue
upon the Plantation where I now live during the Term of her Natural life
and I do herewith most Earnestly Exhort and request all my Children to love Honour
respect and Assist her as their Dear Loving Mother and I do give to my said
Loving wife Mary all my personal Estate during her Natural life and to
make sale of either Horses or Cattle so long as she and my self shall live and
after her Decease my will and Decease is that all my Personal Estate be Equally
Divided equally amongst my six Children here after named

Secondly I will that my Tract of two hundred and Eighty Nine Acres of Land be Equally

Divided in two parts of which my son Mathias Willheit is to have the one
Part and my youngest son Philipp Willheit is to have the other part whereon
whereon the House and Plantation is and whereon I now do live and it
is my Desire that after the Decease of my loving wife Mary and when this
above said by two sons Mathias Willheit and Philipp Willheit are at the ages
of twenty one years each that then the aforesaid my two younger sons do pay
Twelve pounds Currency to the four following my Children as their share
of Inheritance, that is to say unto Tobias Willheit Three pounds Currency
John Willheit three pounds Currency unto Adam Willheit Three pounds Currency
and unto my Daughter Eva (now married to Michael Kell) three pounds
Currency.

Lastly I make and ordain my loving friend Michael Kell and my Dear eldest
son Tobias Willheit to be Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
revoaking all other Wills heretofore by me made and in Witnesst hereof that this
being my last Will and Testament I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first

Day of January 17th 1643

At a Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 26th Day of June 1786
 This Will was presented and read by John Nichol one of the Executors therein named
 Sworn by the Oaths of Michael Holt and Nathaniel Blankinship two of the Witnesses
 thereto who made Oath that they saw John Nichol the other Witness subscribe his name
 as attesting and Obedient to be recorded and on the Motion of the said Executor who made
 Oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Probate
 thereof in due form giving thereby the other Ed. appearing on Court refused to join
 in the same upon he with Edmund Tucker and Leonard Gann his securities
 entered into and Acknowledged their Bond for his due and faithful Adminⁿ of
 the said Decedents Estate
