to my beloved daughter Ann Cook & my son in law John Cook an negro
girl named Betty her & her issues to have & to hold for ever I leave
I do certify that all the remainder of my Estate both real and personal
after my wife's decease or after the death of my son in law as aforesaid
I leave & bequeath to the highest bidder within six months after my decease
