happen at which time I give to my said Daughter Francis my Negro girl named Liddy
whos future increase if she be then living as her full part of my Estate but if the said
Liddy should die before my said Daughter or shall be entitled to her then my will is that
she shall have an equal part with my other Daughters of my Estate when it shall be
that my estate be kept together undivided
Divided till my youngest Child which shall be living attains the age of Fourteen years
or during my wife or widowhood or natural life (except the Legacy given my Daughters)
at either of which times that shall first happen I give and devise to my sons Rich-
ard, Johnson, Philip, John, Charles, & Reuben my Lands to be equally divided amongst
them and their Heirs forever but it is my will and intent that my said wife Elizabeth
shall possess and enjoy the houses where she now lives and one hundred acres of Land adjoin-
