& her future increase if she be then living as her full part of my Estate but if the said
Liddy should die before my said Daughter shall be entitled to her then my will is that
she shall have an equal part with my other Daughters of my Estate when it shall be
divided ^{that my estate be kept together undivided} till my youngest Child which shall be living attains the age of Fourteen Years
or during my wife's widowhood or natural life (except the Legacy given my Daughter)
at either of which times that shall first happen I give and devise to my sons Rich-
ard, Johnson, Philip, John, Charles, & Reuben my Land to be equally divided amongst
them and their heirs forever but it is my will and intent that my said wife Elizabeth
shall possess and enjoy the houses whereon I now live and one hundred acres of Land and join
thereunto ~~all the rest and residue of my Estate~~ ^{all the rest and residue of my Estate}
